Update on Church of Cavaillon, Haiti

The Clements would like to once again thank the Westminster Church for their support in finishing the Adventist Church in Cavaillon, Haiti. With your help, we were able to put the tiles, finish all the stucco and almost complete the painting. Minor work, such as installing the water pump for the bathrooms and landscaping, remains at this time. New pictures will be shown during the offering today.

The church is well and standing after the earthquake. However, the dedication that was scheduled for March 28th has been postponed due to the earthquake in Haiti.

The conference in Haiti was supposed to provide the pews and furnishings, but, due to the earthquake, the conference's funds are depleted in taking care of church members affected by the earthquake and repairing the church buildings damaged or destroyed in other areas.

We will let you know in advance when the new dedication date has been selected, as Pastor Tom may plan a two-week evangelical crusade to coincide with the dedication.
